In 1240, Geoffroy de Montdragon, one of Louis IX's knights, was sent by the king to the Camargue, to buy the land belonging to the Abbey of Psalmody. King Louis had plans to build a town on this hostile marshland. The town would be the only port in France with access to the Mediterranean. A few years later, at the Château de Pontoise, Louis IX survived a serious illness and vowed to launch a crusade to liberate the Holy Land. Thanks to Saint Louis, this small vil-

lage in the Camargue underwent a transformation. The new town was built during the course of the 7th crusade (1248), and continued during the 8th crusade (1270), until the famous ramparts were completed. Thus, the fate of the Kingdom of France became linked to the history of Aigues-Mortes.


